

## ADMISSION STEPS

# VOCATIONAL NURSING

### (1 YEAR-CERTIFICATE)

The applicant must complete and submit an "HCCS Application for Admission" on line at <http://saweb.hccs.cc.tx.us> if no previous enrollment or testing activity has taken place at HCCS.

## REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION

- \_\_\_\_\_ 1. Attend a mandatory on-campus Information Session. Information Sessions are held the second Wednesday of every month, at 12pm and the fourth Wednesday of every month, at 5pm in the Auditorium.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2. Submit the following documentation to the Welcome Center/Room 111, located at 1900 Pressler St., Houston, TX 77030.
  - Application for Health Sciences Program
  - Official High school transcript or official GED scores  
Passing NET (Nursing Entrance Test) Scores: Math 70%: Reading 60% (**NET exam is administered through Educational Resources, Inc. For testing dates and more information call 1-800-292-2273.**)
  - Completion of VNSG 1216 Nutrition and VNSG 1320 Anatomy and Physiology for Allied Health will be required for program acceptance effective Fall 2008. Passing NET scores are required prior to registering for these courses.
  - Completion of HPRS 1201 "Introduction to Health Professions" is highly recommended.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 3. Wait to be contacted, in writing, by the Department Chair for selection process instructions.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 4. If accepted, a condition of acceptance is the passing of a criminal background check and drug screening at an agency approved by HCCS after acceptance but prior to the start of class.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 5. If accepted, attend mandatory VNSG Program orientation.

## INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

- All International Students with F1 visa interested in Health Sciences Program MUST contact the International Student Operations Office at 3100 Main, Houston, Texas 77002, 11<sup>th</sup> floor, corner of Main and Elgin, 713-718-8520.
- Foreign transcripts (high school and college) must be evaluated by an approved evaluation institution (Ex. SpanTran, Global Credentials) and it must be a course-by-course evaluation.

## START OF CLASSES

- Classes begin in the spring and fall semesters. Courses are taught during the day only. (May have evening clinical).

## APPLICATION DEADLINES

- **SPRING:** October 1st
- **FALL:** June 1st
