Registrar and IT Responsibilities

- I. Complete Rollover Course Schedules by Published Timeline Due Dates (See Calendar Page)

Department/Division Responsibilities

- I. Complete Course Schedules by Published Timeline “PeopleSoft Schedule Update” Due Dates.
- II. Provide Program Coordinator **ONE** of the following reports for Summer, Fall and Spring semesters:
 - PeopleSoft Excel Spreadsheet of Completed Course Schedule that includes course rubric and number, location, term, delivery method, and enrollment caps for each course section.
 - PeopleSoft Excel Spreadsheet of Completed Course Schedule that includes course rubric and number, location, term, delivery method, and enrollment caps, plus selected textbooks for each course by number of sections.
- III. Create **optional** detailed Excel Spreadsheet book listing by Course, Book, and Bookstore location for distribution to Barnes and Noble buyer (tm515@bncollege.com), local campus Bookstore managers, and for department/division monitoring of local Bookstore inventories. These detailed listings can be updated as to actual enrollment numbers for more precise monitoring of inventories up to the start of each term (See Sample Listing at end of this document)

Program Coordinator Responsibilities

- I. Complete Textbook Adoptions and Requisition Template form, listing no more than four books per page and indicating the projected enrollments for each Bookstore location, DE, and Dual-Credit (where applicable)
- II. Submit completed Book Adoptions and Requisition form in .pdf by published timeline due dates to:

 - rosa.padron@hccs.edu (Workforce Programs)
- III. Distribute completed Textbook Adoptions and Requisition Template form to all Program Committee members and Department/Division Chairs.

About the Revised Textbook Adoptions and Requisitions Template

The form/template to be used for Program text and textbook adoptions and requisitions has been revised effective for Spring 2012. The new form asks Program Coordinators and/or Directors to list their program's selections by HCC Bookstores as opposed to the old form that was by college. Bookstores are listed by their PeopleSoft campus code. Distance Education, books are still to be listed separately, but without CRNs. In addition, the new form also includes dual-credit selections in a separate column along with another column that allows Coordinators to indicate the bookstore where those books are to be stocked, also by campus code. A complete list of all nine bookstores, their codes and the codes for the campuses they service can be found on the last page of these instructions. The template is to be used for all HCC programs, whether academic or workforce.

Other changes in the template include a limit of listing four books per page, plus a column that shows the publisher's suggested retail price for each text or textbook. Do not add additional rows, but copy and paste blank template pages to the end of the form if additional rows are needed. The template is designed in a way make this copying and pasting simple and quick. Additionally, this template is also designed to make it easier to match daily enrollment reports with each of the HCC Bookstores and the campuses they serve. Most important is that individual bookstore managers, department/division chairs, and faculty will have documentation of those texts and textbooks that are to be in stock at their respective locations. **However, for this new approach to work well, it is essential that all those involved work together to make it happen.**

Program Coordinators and/or Directors responsible for completing the template form are to request a copy of the upcoming semester schedule from each department/division, along with a course by course listing of the texts or textbooks to be used by their faculty. This listing should include the campus where the course will be taught. The easiest way to do this is for department/divisions to provide the PeopleSoft Excel spreadsheet that includes campus codes for all courses. In cases where different texts are used for the same course being serviced by a particular bookstore, departments/divisions must include a supplemental list that includes both the book selections and number of sections involved. For example, some programs allow faculty a choice of four separate textbooks to be used for a particular course. In those cases, a breakdown of the number of sections using each of those textbooks must be provided and must again indicate their campus locations by code so that the Coordinator and/or Director can make certain the correct number of books are ordered for the bookstores servicing those courses. In most cases, the number of books is the total seats available, e.g. 25 to 35 for on campus sections and 35 for DE sections.

Departments/Divisions can further enhance the probability that the correct books will be at their respective bookstores by creating a detailed listing of all courses and their text or textbook selections by location and CRN for their own records and for Coordinators and/or Managers creating the adoption/requisition form. This detailed listing can then be forwarded on to local Bookstore managers, though it is strongly suggested any detailed list should be separated to include texts or textbooks ordered for particular stores and DE. This will further document what is to be in stock and avoid confusing the Bookstore managers and staff. Detailed listings by Departments/Divisions should be ordered by term, e.g. RT, F8A, SS, F8B, etc.
