



HCC's Historical Commitment to the Spring Branch Community

HCC investments in the community: \$35 million capital investment and \$16 million annual investment

- 1986** SBISD asked HCC to offer classes at the Westchester Campus, which was closed due to SBISD's enrollment decrease.
- 1986** HCC expands programs and class offerings at the Westchester Campus and enrollment grows to 3,200 students.
- 1992** HCC offers Dual Credit classes for SBISD students.
- 1995** State legislature puts Spring Branch into the Houston Community College service area.
- 1999** HCC opens the Town and Country Campus to serve 3,600 students, and enrollment quickly grows to 6,500 students.
- 2005** Community visioning sessions begin to gather input and ideas about higher education opportunities in Spring Branch.
- 2009** HCC and SBISD partner on the Early College High School program.
- 2009** Town and Country Campus was rededicated as the Spring Branch Campus and currently serves 7,000 students.

Representation

Upon annexation, the Spring Branch community will have representation on the HCC Board. The Board determines who will serve as interim Trustee until the next scheduled election. Residents will have the opportunity to vote for the candidate of their choice at that time. Redistricting will occur in 2011, based on the 2010 census.
