Certified Nurse Aide Certificate

In order to meet the rising demand for trained personnel in the health care industry, HCC offers a Certified Nurse Aide (CNA) Certificate, a model program for fast-track training that produces successful graduates sought after for entry-level positions in the field.

What skills will I learn?

HCC's CNA program will provide the skills, knowledge and abilities essential to providing basic care to residents of long-term care facilities. You will learn about resident's rights, communication, safety, observation, reporting and assisting residents in maintaining basic comfort and safety.

What jobs can I get?

CNA training prepares you for entry-level employment in long-term care facilities, doctor's offices, home health/hospice agencies and hospitals. Income will depend on what area of employment you choose.

Upon completion of this six-week course you will be eligible for the State Licensing Exam (\$83). Once employed in the industry, your CNA basic training,

along with additional education, will open a variety of career paths such as Medical Assistant, Licensed Vocational Nurse, Licensed Practical Nurse, Phlebotomy Technician and Registered Nurse.

When do I attend class?

Monday through Thursday, (class times vary). Start date is subject to change to ensure sufficient student enrollment. We offer weekend classes Friday 5:30 p.m. until 9:30 p.m. and Saturday 8:30 a.m. until 4:30 p.m..

How long does the training last?

The length is 6 weeks (96 hours). Classes will run every spring, summer and fall semester. An orientation session will be held prior to the start of each registration period.
