Students are trained to perform a variety of blood collection methods, with an emphasis on safety, quality assurance, patient identification and specimen handling. Following the lecture/student lab class, students will be placed in a clinical setting to further develop the skill of venipuncture on actual patients.

The Phlebotomy Technician Certificate is designed to prepare students to take a national certification exam.
