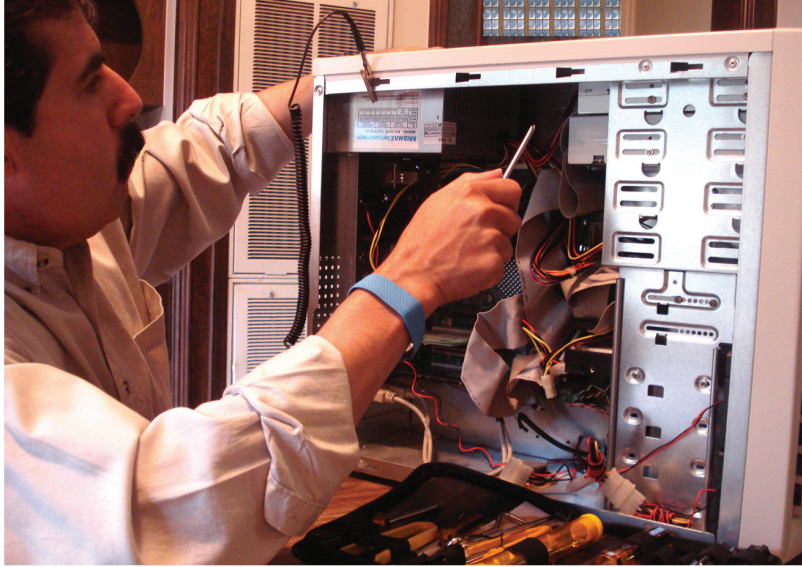

What is A+ Certification?

A+ Certification is a testing program sponsored by CompTIA that certifies the competency of entry-level (6 months experience) service technicians in the computer industry. Anyone who wants an internationally recognized credential as a competent entry-level computer service professional can take the A+ examination. Successful completion of this course and A+ certification is recommended prior to enrollment in MCSE certification courses.

Who should attend this class?

Anyone who wants to learn the skills required to gain entry into the growing field of technology or to update skills to start a new career. The Certification also shows that you have the understanding of customer relations skills that have been critically lacking in the industry.

Who hires PC Technicians?

Major computer hardware and software vendors, distributors, resellers and publications back the program.
