

POLICE IN-SERVICE TRAINING

EPCT 1052 Hazardous Materials: Operations Level (40 hrs.)

This course will have an emphasis on identification and proper handling of hazardous materials per 29CFR 1910.120 (q). Includes regulations, emergency situations, and notification procedures in emergency response plans, spill containment, and proper use of personal protective equipment.

TECM 1013 Occupational Math for Crime Scene & Traffic Collision (40 hrs.)

Math for crime scene and traffic collision investigators, math skills applicable to business and industry for successful on-the-job performance in investigations of crime and traffic collisions.

HMSY 1011 Computer Crime (16 hrs)

Student will understand the role of law enforcement investigator in cyber terrorism as well as criminal use of computers and the internet and identify the tools used to monitor the internet and forensic analysis of computers seized in investigations. Students will be exposed to search warrants, protecting computer evidence, and obtaining information from offenders.

HMSY 1025 Emergency Management: Personal and Community Preparedness and Education (8 hrs)

Student will understand the study of emergency management and preparedness for terrorist activities including world issues, strategies for community readiness, information on disasters, disaster kit preparation, and terrorism issues.

HMSY 2021 Explosives/Improvised Explosives (8 hrs)

Student will learn how to identify improvised explosive devices based on the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms (ATF) explosives guidelines.

HMSY 1023 Medical Management of Chemical Casualties (8 hrs)

Student will learn how to manage contaminated casualties and to provide the earliest and most effective treatment without compounding injuries or contaminating medical personnel and treatment facilities.

HMSY 2036 Training Academy Terrorism Foundation (8 hrs)

Student will learn how to identify terrorists operations and how to survive following a disaster.

HMSY 1012 Interagency Interaction (8 hrs)

Student will learn how to work with multiple agencies to plan for and combat terrorism.]

HMSY 1020 Identification of Threat Characteristics (8 hrs)

Course will include the identification of weapons of mass destruction (WMD) and its effects on the environment.

HMSY 2035 Street Officer Survival (8 hrs)

Course review various agencies in the Department of Homeland Security and police officer roles and responsibilities in the war on terrorism.
