Notes: The TRS retiree is solely responsible for monitoring courses/hours. These are TRS rules and not HCC work restrictions.

One-half time employment is the maximum allowed by TRS without forfeiting pension for the month.

Work effort may not exceed one-half of the time a full-time employee would have worked or 92 hours, whichever is less.

If paid by course, no more two (2) courses may be taught in any calendar month.

CAUTION: If a course ends and another begins in the **SAME** month, they are added together as the total taught in the month.

If paid for two courses, additional hourly paid work may not exceed the Maximum Additional Hours shown in any given month.
