CALL TO ORDER

Ms. Mullins, Chair called the meeting to order at 3:54 p.m. and declared the Committee convened to consider matters pertaining to Houston Community College as listed on the duly posted Meeting Notice.

83rd LEGISLATIVE SESSION UPDATE

Mr. Remmele Young provided an update regarding the 83rd Legislative Session.

Ms. Mullins requested that the overview focus on the successes and the options that can be considered regarding the failures.

Mr. Young informed that the amount to be paid back to the state has actually been reduced. Dr. Tyler apprised that the amount was reduced from \$8 million to approximately \$6.9 million.

Mr. Young provided an update as it relates to TRS and ORP contributions.

- TRS contribution limited to 50% of state contribution of 6.4% for FY 2014 and 6.8% for FY 2015
- ORP contribution limited to 50% of state contribution of 6.6% of total covered
- Each community college district's retirement allocation is contingent upon repayment of amount owed to state for FY2012-13

Mr. Austin inquired if the benefit cost has been increasing over the years. Dr. Tyler noted that the amount has been flat until this year. He informed that it benefits the employee because the contributions increase.

Mr. Young continued with the presentation to include:

Mr. Robinson requested that the legislative team calculate dual credit regarding the limits of students. Mr. Paul Colbert informed that the hour limitation was an amendment.

Mr. Robinson inquired who would provide clarification. Mr. Young apprised that the legislative team and external relations will review and provide clarification on the issue.

Mr. Robinson welcomed Dr. Terry Grier, Superintendent with Houston Independent School Dr. Grier expressed appreciation to HCC for their partnership.
