As outlined in CDA (Legal), Accounting – Financial Reports and Statements, and CRA (Legal), Technology Resources – Website Postings, a state agency, including a college district, that maintains a generally accessible Internet site or for which a generally accessible Internet site is maintained, shall include a link on the agency’s Internet site to the State Expenditure Database.
